What is the National Honor Society for Dance Arts?

The **National Honor Society for Dance Arts** (NHSDA) is a program of the National Dance Education Organization. It is one of the most exciting benefits NDEO offers its Institutional Members. The Secondary Program (grades 9-12) was implemented in 2005. The Collegiate Program was implemented in 2012, and a Junior Program (grades 6-8) was separated from the Secondary Program and officially launched in 2016. To date, there are close to 400 chapters in the US and almost 3,000 students have been inducted since 2013.

The National Honor Society for Dance Arts is run on an institutional basis. Chapters at the Junior, Secondary, and Collegiate level are set up at individual schools, and only students who are enrolled at that school may apply for induction. Individual students, not enrolled at a school that hosts a current NHSDA Chapter, are not eligible for induction.

Mission

 To recognize outstanding artistic merit, leadership, and academic achievement in students studying dance in public and private schools in K-12 education, dance studios, cultural/community centers, performing arts organizations, and post-secondary education.
 To foster an appreciation for dance as a true art form and one worthy of recognition and prestige. Participating in the NHSDA chapter in your school is one very important way you can help advance the field of dance education. Your honor society celebrates the artistic merit, leadership, and academic achievements of exceptional dance students (like you!) and helps to create honor and prestige within and without the dance community at large.

Student Benefits

1. Recognition of **artistic merit, academic achievement, and leadership** throughout your educational experience. (Junior High – Collegiate)

2. Certificates at each level of induction, from the gold Honor Pin to the blue and white Graduation Honor Cord.

3. Mentorship from Chapter Sponsor and peer networking.

4. Leadership and development opportunities within NHSDA Chapter = assist Chapter Sponsor with Chapter administration, record keeping, fundraising, and event planning.

NHSDA National induction Point System 2022-2023

Membership in NHSDA is based on a designated point system. Secondary Members (grades 9-12) must achieve 100 points to maintain eligibility, 80 of which must be earned through participation in chapter site program activities. Point trackers are submitted for administrative review upon the dancer's completed actions.

In all cases, prospective/active member's consistent demonstration of teamwork, motivation and commitment to the art of dance is always an important factor in determining/maintaining eligibility for membership. Administrator(s) will rely on confidential anecdotal records and familiarity with the students in determining whether or not membership requirements have been met. Administrators will use their discretion in awarding points – from zero to the maximum-according to the quality of the work performed in a given activity.

All prospective members who have met the eligibility criteria must pay the one time membership fee established by NHSDA prior to induction.

**Candidates may submit activities from April 1st through present date for consideration.

**Secondary: At least 100 points required for induction, 80 of which must be earned through participation in chapter site program activities.
